## ARTICLE "III"

### **3.1 Membership Conditions:**

3.1.1 Applicants must be 18 years of age and over.

3.1.2 Members' children between the ages of 14-18 years of full time students shall be exempt from membership fees on submission of an application subject to the approval of the Executive Committee. Such members shall have no voting privileges. Members' children, and all other immediate family members (brothers/sisters) who are 19 years of age and non-students are considered as non-members.

3.1.3 Membership is open to all Canadians.

3.1.4 All applications for membership must be seconded by two members of the Society. Members recommending new applicants are full responsible for the behaviour of the new member during the probationary period.

3.1.5 A new member is to be considered under probation for a period of one year prior to his/her voting eligibility.

3.1.6 All applicants must submit an official application after thoroughly digesting the Society's Constitution.

3.1.7 All membership fees must be remitted annually. The payment will be due as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of each year for established members. For new applicants the payments will be due immediately after approval of their applications.

3.1.8 Honorary membership may be granted to persons of distinction who have special interest in the Society and its objectives. Such persons may be granted board of trustees to the General Body Meeting.

3.1.9 Any member may terminate his/her membership by filling and submitting a membership termination form.

3.1.10 Any member may be required to resign by a vote of three quarters of the members at an Annual Meeting.

3.1.11 A member expelled from the membership for conduct detrimental to the Society will not be reinstated unless the Executive Committee receives in writing the approval of his/her re-acceptance form three quarters of the voting members.

3.1.12 A member expelled has no right to participate in any of the Society's activities as a non-member.

3.1.13 members achieving distinguished accomplishments towards the Society aims, upon recommendations by the Executive Committee or by the Board of Trustees, such members should be recommended to receive an appropriate recognition award.

3.1.14 In case of death of an active member the remaining spouse will be granted a free lifetime membership.`

3.1.15 All members are obligated to offer help towards the Society's functions when such call is deemed necessary by the Executive Committee. All members are encouraged to participate in General Body Meetings and social activities.

### **3.2 Membership Fees:**

3.2.1 Annual subscription fee is required from members as follows:

- a) Single \$100.00 – vote eligibility one only. Due January 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.
- b) Family : \$200.00- vote eligibility two only. Due January 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.
- c) All lifetime and senior members previously exempted shall pay the annual subscription fees.
